Legends of Lawsuit Reform Endorse Moseley

AUSTIN, TEXAS — Lawsuit reform legends Dr. John Coppedge of Longview and Ralph Wayne of Austin have endorsed Justice Jim Moseley for Texas Supreme Court, Place 3, in the March 2, 2010, Republican primary election.

Coppedge, a retired general surgeon, founded the Bipartisan Justice Committee in 1987 and served for a decade on the Texas Medical Association political action committee board. Wayne is the former president of the Texas Civil Justice League, the state's first legal reform coalition, and chairman emeritus of the American Tort Reform Association. He also served as a member of the Texas House of Representatives and as chairman of the Texas Ethics Commission.

"Jim Moseley is one of the state's finest judges," said Coppedge. *"No other candidate in this race has his experience or record on the bench."*

"Justice Moseley has written more than a thousand civil and criminal opinions during his 13 years on the Court of Appeals," said Wayne. *"His legal scholarship and commitment to public service is unequalled."*

Moseley has been endorsed by former Governor William P. Clements, Jr., Congressmen Kenney Marchant and Pete Sessions, Republican National Committee representatives Cathie Adams of Dallas and Bill Crocker of Austin, 18 State Republican Executive Committee members, and numerous current and former Republican elected officials. He has also received the support former State Bar of Texas presidents Darrell Jordan and Harriet Miers of Dallas, Lonny Morrison of Wichita Falls, and Guy Harrison of Longview.

A native of Eastland County, Moseley was appointed to the 5th Court of Appeals by Governor George W. Bush in 1996. Prior to taking the bench, he practiced law for 14 years in Dallas and Odessa. Moseley is a graduate of Baylor University and its School of Law. He and his wife of 26 years, Marian, reside in Coppell and have two children.
