**Republican Justice Jim Moseley Announces
Endorsements From Two More Former State Bar Presidents**

Harriet Miers and Lonny Morrison Join in Endorsing Moseley for Texas Supreme Court Place 3

Dallas - Justice Jim Moseley announced today the endorsement of two former Presidents of the State Bar of Texas: Harriet Miers of Dallas and Lonny Morrison of Wichita Falls. The two former Bar Presidents are supporting Justice Moseley in his race for Texas Supreme Court, Place 3. Moseley is currently on the Fifth District Court of Appeals in Dallas.

"Justice Jim Moseley and I have been friends for over twenty years," said Harriet Miers. "For nine years we practiced law together. His success as a lawyer and his reputation as an outstanding appellate justice demonstrate he has the experience, the skills, the judicial temperament, and the work ethic we want on the Texas Supreme Court. I hope all Texans will join me in supporting Jim Moseley."

Harriet Miers served as the first female President of the State Bar of Texas from 1992-1993. Ms. Miers served in the President George W. Bush administration from 2001-2007 as Staff Secretary, Deputy Chief of Staff, and Counsel to the President, before returning to Dallas to resume her career with Locke Lord Bissell & Liddell. Before going to the White House, Miers was

Said Lonny Morrison: "I know Justice Jim Moseley has a reputation as a fair and balanced appellate justice. But I know more than that. Jim and I first met on opposite sides of a lawsuit over 25 years ago. During that lawsuit I came to respect his integrity and honesty. We've been friends ever since." Morrison added, "Jim's the kind of person we all hope will serve Texas on the Supreme Court. He has my full support, and I'm looking forward to seeing him take the oath of office in Austin."

Lonny Morrison succeeded Harriet Miers as the President of the State Bar of Texas, serving from 1993-1994. A graduate of the University of Texas School of Law, Mr. Morrison resides and practices law in Wichita Falls.

The endorsements of Miers and Morrison follow endorsements Justice Moseley received from two other former State Bar Presidents, Guy Harrison of Longview and Darrell Jordan of Dallas. Justice Moseley has also been endorsed by both RNC Committeewoman (now Republican Party of Texas Chair) Cathie Adams and RNC Committeeman Bill Crocker. Justice Jim Moseley has also been endorsed by the Texas Restaurant Association.

In announcing these endorsements, Justice Moseley said, "To have the support of Harriet Miers and Lonny Morrison is a real honor. They are both leaders of character and integrity, who served our profession with honor during their terms as President of the State Bar. I couldn't be happier to have their support."

Justice Moseley was appointed to the Dallas Court of Appeals in 1996 by Governor George W. Bush. In a recent Judicial Evaluation Poll conducted by the Dallas Bar Association, Moseley was the highest-rated justice on the Dallas court of appeals. He served as Chair of the State Bar's Antitrust & Business Litigation Section in 2007-08. Moseley has been active in the Republican Party, serving as a precinct chairman, county-vice chairman, county chairman, and a member of the party's state executive committee. Moseley is also a founding member of the Dallas Lawyers' chapter of the Federalist Society, a conservative legal organization.
