**Republican Justice Jim Moseley Announces  
Endorsement From Former Texas Supreme Court Justice**

**The Honorable Craig T. Enoch Endorses Jim Moseley for Texas Supreme Court Place 3**

Dallas - Justice Jim Moseley announced today the endorsement of former Texas Supreme Court Justice Craig T. Enoch.

"Justice Jim Moseley is the kind of person Texans need on the Supreme Court," said Enoch. "He has a tremendous legal mind and a proven, 13-year record of interpreting the Constitution and laws of the State of Texas as they are written. Jim will be a strong, experienced, conservative voice on the Court. I hope all Texans will join me in working to elect Justice Jim Moseley to the Texas Supreme Court."

Justice Enoch served on the Texas Supreme Court from 1993-2003. Before then, he served as a district court judge and as Chief Justice of the Fifth District Court of Appeals in Dallas—the court where Justice Moseley serves now. After leaving the Texas Supreme Court, Enoch became a shareholder in the Winstead law firm; located in the firm's Austin office, he chairs Winstead's Appellate Practice Group. Enoch is a graduate of SMU, both undergrad and law, as has an LLM from the University of Virginia School of Law.

In announcing Enoch's endorsement, Justice Moseley said, "Craig Enoch served Texans well as a district judge, a justice on the court of appeals, and as a member of the Texas Supreme Court. I am honored by his support. He knows I am well-prepared to serve on the Supreme Court, and I hope Texans across the state feel the same way."

Enoch's endorsement of Justice Moseley follows the endorsements Justice Moseley has received from four former State Bar Presidents, Harriet Miers, Lonny Morrison, Guy Harrison, and Darrell Jordan. Justice Moseley has also been endorsed by Republican National Committeewoman (now Republican Party of Texas Chair) Cathie Adams and RNC Committeeman Bill Crocker. Justice Jim Moseley has also been endorsed by the Texas Restaurant Association.

Justice Moseley was appointed to the Dallas Court of Appeals in 1996 by Governor George W. Bush. In a recent Judicial Evaluation Poll conducted by the Dallas Bar Association, Moseley was the highest-rated justice on the Dallas court of appeals. He served as Chair of the State Bar's Antitrust & Business Litigation Section in 2007-08. Moseley has been active in the Republican Party, serving as a precinct chairman, county-vice chairman, county chairman, and a member of the party's state executive committee. Moseley is also a founding member of the Dallas Lawyers' chapter of the Federalist Society, a conservative legal organization.
