**Former Texas Governor William P. Clements
Endorses Justice Jim Moseley for Texas Supreme Court**

Dallas - Justice Jim Moseley announced today the endorsement of former Texas Governor William P. Clements. Moseley is currently on the Fifth District Court of Appeals in Dallas.

In announcing his endorsement, Governor Clements said, "Justice Jim Moseley is a committed conservative, a strong Republican, and an outstanding Justice. His thirteen-year record on the Court of Appeals proves he is exactly the type of person Texans need on the Supreme Court. I'm proud to endorse Jim and I encourage all Texans to support him."

In announcing the endorsement from former Governor Clements, Justice Moseley stated: "I've known Governor Clements since the early 1980s, when he and Rita came to Odessa to help us raise money for the local Republican Party. He is bigger than life--one of those persons who changed Texas and the Republican Party." Justice Moseley continued, "Governor Clements's commitment to a strong, conservative Texas judiciary is unquestioned. I thank him for standing with me in this race. I'll work hard to make sure he and all Texans are proud of their Supreme Court."

William P. Clements was the 42nd and 44th Governor of Texas, serving from 1979-1983 and from 1987-1991. Clements was the first Republican Governor of Texas since Reconstruction. Clements and his wife Rita reside in Dallas. In June 2009, Clements donated \$100 million to UT Southwestern Medical Center, the largest civic donation in Dallas history.

Former Governor Clements's endorsement of Justice Moseley follows the recent endorsements Moseley has received from Congressman Pete Sessions and Congressman Kenny Marchant. Moseley has also been endorsed by four previous Presidents of the State Bar of Texas: Harriet Miers and Darrell Jordan from Dallas, Lonny Morrison from Wichita Falls, and Guy Harrison from Longview. Justice Jim Moseley has been endorsed by former Texas Supreme Court Justice Craig T. Enoch. Moseley was previously endorsed by Republican National Committee Committeewoman Cathie Adams and Committeeman Bill Crocker, along with many party leaders and grassroots activists from the S.R.E.C. and precincts across Texas, and the Texas Restaurant Association.

Justice Moseley was appointed to the Dallas Court of Appeals in 1996 by Governor George W. Bush. In a recent Judicial Evaluation Poll conducted by the Dallas Bar Association, Moseley was the highest-rated justice on the Dallas court. Moseley has been active in the Republican Party, serving as a precinct chairman, county-vice chairman, county chairman, and a member of the party's state executive committee. Moseley is a founding member of the Dallas Lawyers' chapter of the Federalist Society, a conservative legal organization. Justice Moseley and his wife, Marian, live in Coppell and attend Irving Bible Church.
