Republican Justice Jim Moseley Announces Endorsement of Congressman Kenny Marchant

Dallas - Justice Jim Moseley announced today the endorsement of Texas Congressman Kenny Marchant of the 24th District for his race for the Texas Supreme Court. Moseley is currently on the Fifth District Court of Appeals in Dallas.

"I've known Justice Jim Moseley since 1988 and have worked with him on numerous campaigns for Republican candidates. Jim understands that grassroots campaigning is critical to the success of the Republican Party", said Congressman Marchant. Congressman Marchant continued, "His leadership of Victory '94 in Dallas County was crucial in turning out the vote for the Republican ticket. He is an experienced, proven conservative judge who will exercise restraint at the Texas Supreme Court. I urge you to support Justice Jim Moseley."

In announcing the endorsement from Congressman Marchant, Justice Moseley said, "I am honored to receive the endorsement of such a distinguished leader from Texas. I have known Congressman Marchant for many years now and we have been on the ground together for some interesting election cycles. The Congressman's support is evidence from the wing of the legislative branch that writes the laws, that we need judges to strictly interpret those difficult pieces of legislation that are consistent with the will of the people who elected their legislators." Justice Moseley concluded, "Whether in Texas or in Washington D.C., our judicial principles should not change, they should remain consistent, and I believe I am receiving much of my support because I understand and have adhered to this principle for 13-plus years as a Justice."

The endorsement by Congressman Marchant follows the recent endorsements of four previous Presidents of the State Bar of Texas: Harriet Miers and Darrell Jordan from Dallas, Lonny Morrison, from Wichita Falls, and Guy Harrison, from Longview. Justice Jim Moseley has also been endorsed by former Texas Supreme Court Justice Craig T. Enoch. Moseley was previously endorsed by Committeewoman Cathie Adams, Committeeman Bill Crocker and the Texas Restaurant Association, along with many party leaders and grassroots activists from the S.R.E.C. and precincts across Texas.

Justice Moseley was appointed to the Dallas Court of Appeals in 1996 by Governor George W. Bush. In a recent Judicial Evaluation Poll conducted by the Dallas Bar Association, Moseley was the highest-rated justice on the Dallas court. Moseley has been active in the Republican Party, serving as a precinct chairman, county-vice chairman, county chairman, and a member of the party's state executive committee. Moseley is a founding member of the Dallas Lawyers' chapter of the Federalist Society, a conservative legal organization. Justice Moseley and his wife, Marian, live in Coppell and attend Irving Bible Church.
